

XI INTERNATIONAL MUSIC COURSE IN VALLDEMOSSA - CÁTEDRA CHOPIN -

DATES AND LOCATION

The course will be set in Valldemossa (Majorca) from the 15th until the 19th of July of 2024. It will take place at the Cartoixa of Valldemossa (where the Associació Festivals Chopin is located) and the Music School of Valldemossa, and the CEIP Nicolau Calafat of Valldemossa.

OBJECTIVES OF THE COURSE

The course is addressed to students of elemental, degree students, postgraduates and teachers. The purpose is to give the opportunity to participate in an intensive work program to develop and improve their practical and theoretical knowledge, assist to lectures, concerts, participate in auditions and enjoy the coexistence with students and teachers from different countries in an incomparable place like Valldemossa, evoking the spirit and work of Chopin.

PROFESSORS



NELSON DELLE-VIGNE FABBRI

The Italian virtuoso Nelson Delle-Vigne Fabbri was born in Argentina, where he was instructed by Magda Tagliaferro, Claudio Arrau and Georgy Cziffra. In addition to his performing and recording career, Nelson Delle-Vigne Fabbri is also a famed international piano pedagogue. He is a professor of piano at the Ecole Normale *Alfred Cortot* in Paris, and has also been appointed professor extraordinaire at the Chapelle Musicale *Reine Elisabeth* in Belgium. He gives frequent masterclasses in France, USA, Portugal, Italy, the Netherlands, Spain, Switzerland, Greece. Cultural and pedagogical broadening is an important goal of his duties as general director of the Bell'Arte Foundation. Mr. Delle-Vigne Fabbri is also the artistic director of MUSIC-a Braine l'Alleud, the Paris International Summer Sessions and of the EMS Music Group.

He is usually invited to international piano competitions as jury member.



JOSÉ MARÍA GALLARDO DEL REY

He made his debut in Seville at the age of 8 and since then he has achieved the greatest success with critics and the public. He is recognized internationally as one of the great guitarists of today.

His training as a classical guitarist has been enriched by his intense relationship with the world of flamenco.

Paco de Lucía, Plácido Domingo, Teresa Berganza, Elina Garanca or María Pagés, to name a few, have required his collaboration for his projects.

Deutsche Grammophon artist he has recorded more than 30 CDs throughout his career.

He is an Academician of the Royal Academy of San Carlos of Valencia and currently holds the Andrés Segovia Chair in the International Music Courses in Compostela.



OLIVER KERN

Oliver Kern graduated in piano, conducting and choral conducting at the Staatliche Hochschule für Musik in Stuttgart. He continued his piano studies with Rudolf Buchbinder and Karl-Heinz Kämmerling at the Musik-Akademie in Basel and the Mozarteum in Salzburg.

He has been a professor at Hanyang University in Seoul, at the Hochschule für Musik und Theater in Hamburg and since 2012 at the Hochschule für Musik und Darstellende Kunst in Frankfurt.

He has played in prestigious concert halls around the world, such as the Musikverein and the Konzerthaus in Vienna, the Schauspielhaus in Berlin, the Musikhalle in Hamburg, the Herkulessaal in Munich, the Salle Gaveau in Paris, the Auditorium St. Cecília in Rome, Century Hall in Beijing, Saitama Arts Center in Tokyo or Seoul Arts Center.



KYUNG-AH

Kyung-Ah, she currently teaches at Sejong University and Seoul National University in South Korea. has won numerous competition awards, including the USA Beethoven competition, the Leos Janacek International Competition, the Sorantin International Competition and the St. Charles International Competition, among others.

Since having been selected as the 2013 Artist in the Seoul Arts Center, she has concertized extensively throughout the United States, Europe and Asia. She has collaboration with leading conductors including John Williams, James Orent, Petr Atrichter, and has performed with the Boston Pops Orchestra, Brno Philharmonic Orchestra, Nec Philharmonic Orchestra, Bu Symphony Orchestra, Seoul Philharmonic Orchestra, Seoul Symphony Orchestra, Busan Philharmonic Orchestra and Kyunggi Philharmonic Orchestra.

She recevied the Bachelor of Music, Master of Music and Graduate Diploma from the New England Conservatory, DMA from the Boston University, where she studied with Russell Sherman, Wha Kyung Byun and Boaz Sharon.



MIQUEL ESTELRICH

Born in Palma (Mallorca), he is senior lecturer of piano and founder of the Conservatori Superior de Música de les Illes Balears, which he also directed. His intense and varied activity as a pianist has led him to perform in important theatres as the Kennedy Center in Washington, Teatro de la Zarzuela in Madrid, Teatro Victoria Eugenia in San Sebastian, Palau de la Música in Barcelona, Palau de la Música in Valencia, and various concert halls in Madrid, Zaragoza, Santander, Italy, Bulgary, Portugal, France, Austria, Germany, Japan and China, as soloist, with an orchestra and as chamber musician. He has recorded 14 CD and written 16 books, based on the works of Frédéric Chopin, Baltasar Samper, Jaume Mas Porcel, Joan Maria Thomàs, Miquel Capllonch and Antoni Parera Fons, among others.

He has a doctorate from the Universitat de les Illes Balears and is the pianist of the Orquestra Simfònica de Balears since its foundation in 1989.
